

How to make Landview Run with Windows Vista

(assuming you have already attempted to install Landview)

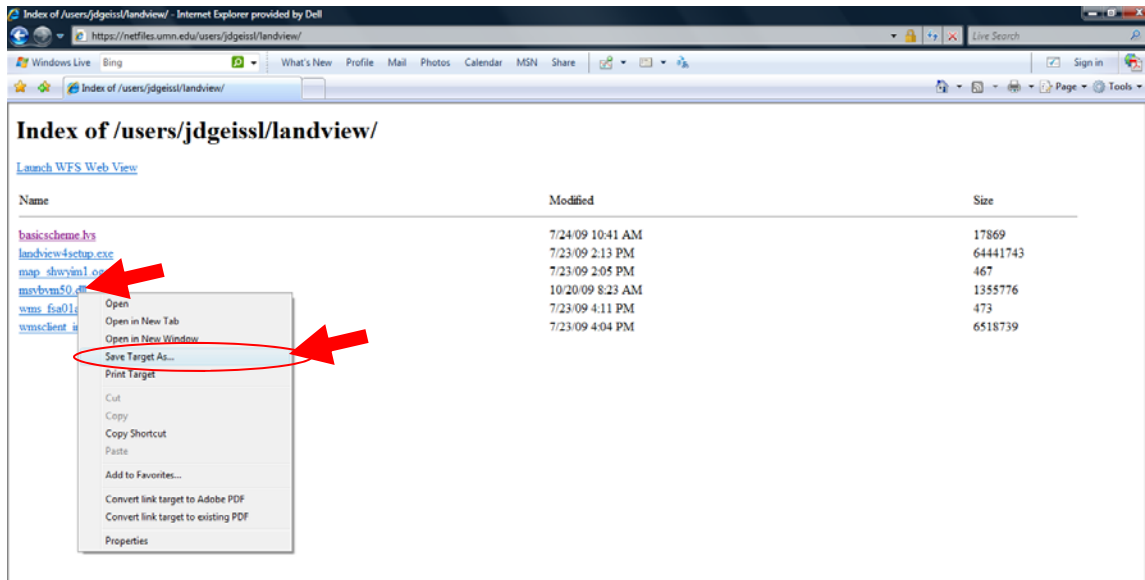
Step 1.

Go to the following website.

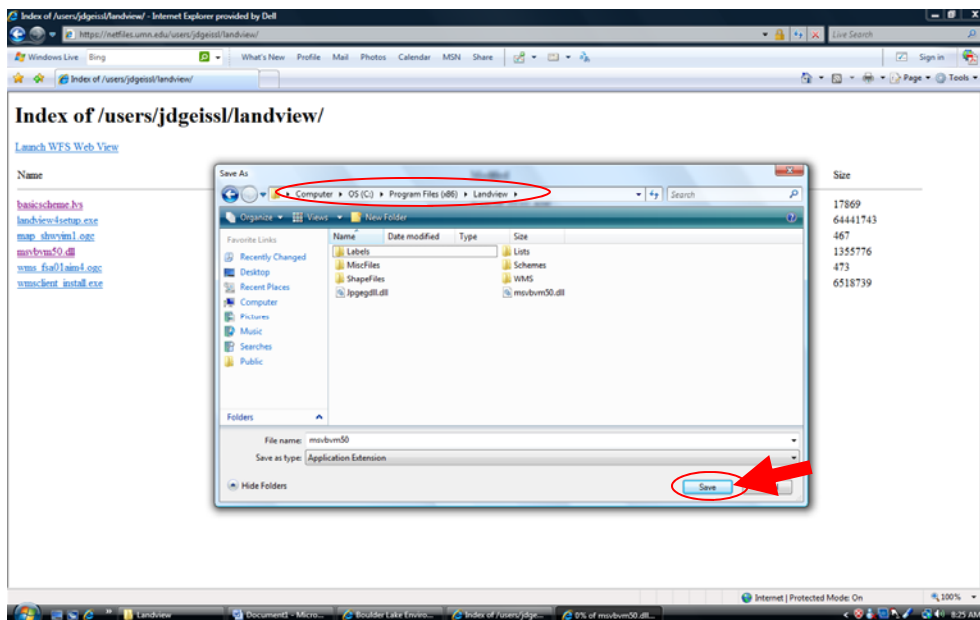

Step 2.

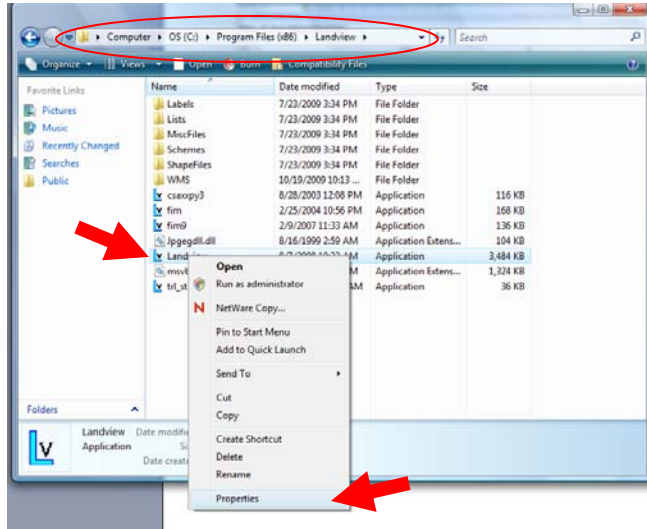
Right click on “msvbvm50.dll” and left click on ‘Save Target As...’



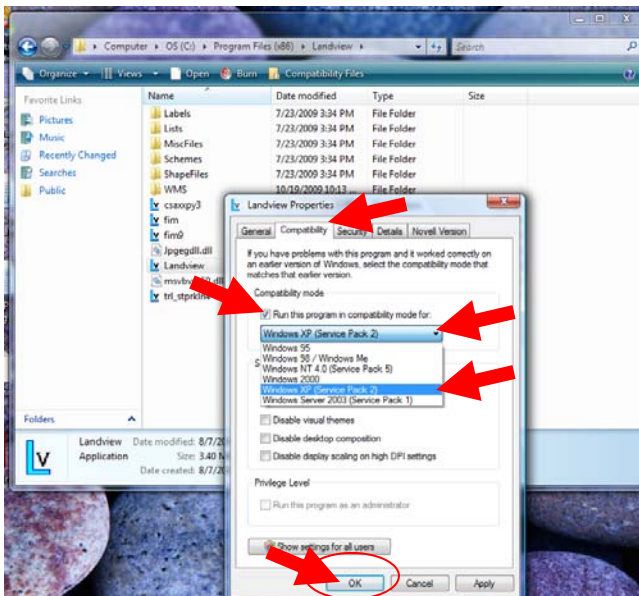
Step 3. The ‘Save As’ window will appear. Save the file under Computer—OS(C:) - Program Files (x86) - Landview and click <Save>.



Step 4. In the bottom left hand corner of your screen click on the Windows icon and then click on “Computer”. Double click on ‘OS (C:)’, then ‘Program Files (x86)’, then ‘Landview’. Your screen should now look like the one below. **Right** click on ‘Landview’ file and left click on ‘Properties’.



Step 5. The Landview Properties window appears. Click on the Compatibility tab. Click in the box next to ‘Run this program in compatibility mode for:’ and then select ‘Windows XP (Service Pack 2)’. Click <OK>.



You should now be able to run Landview :)
